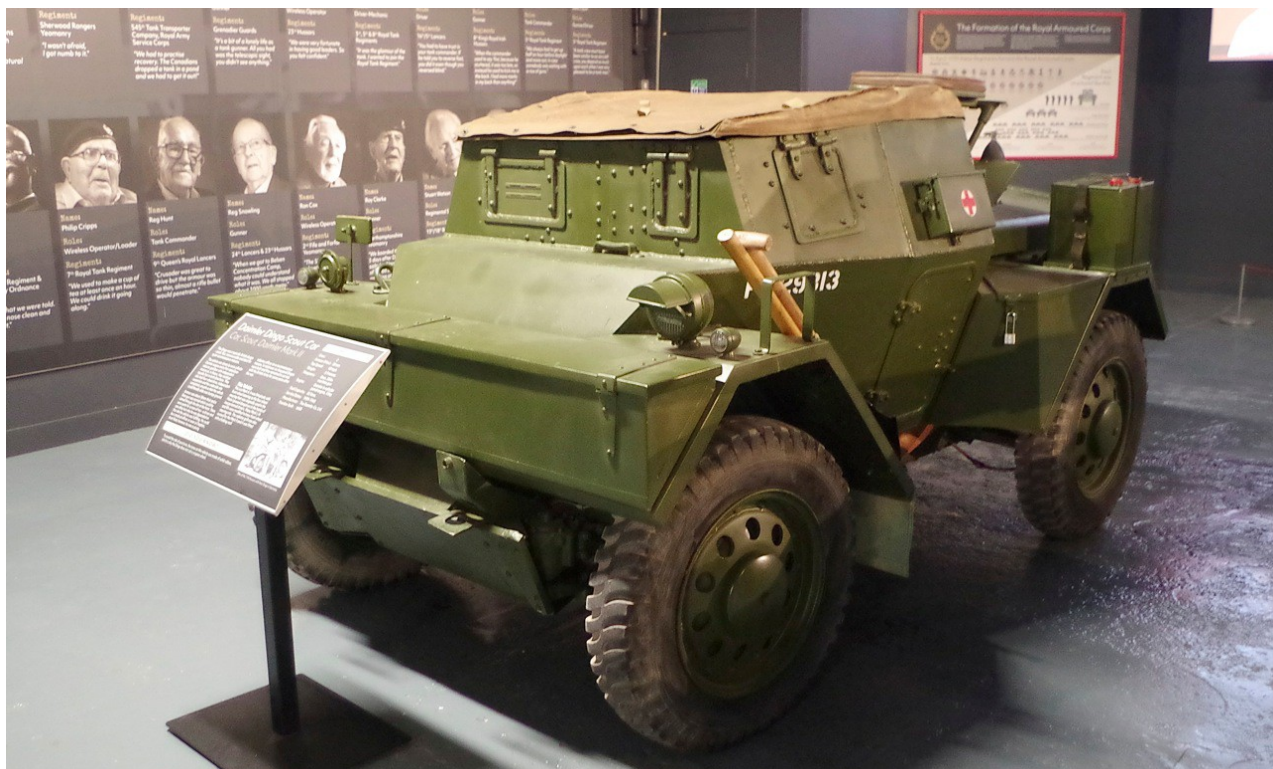

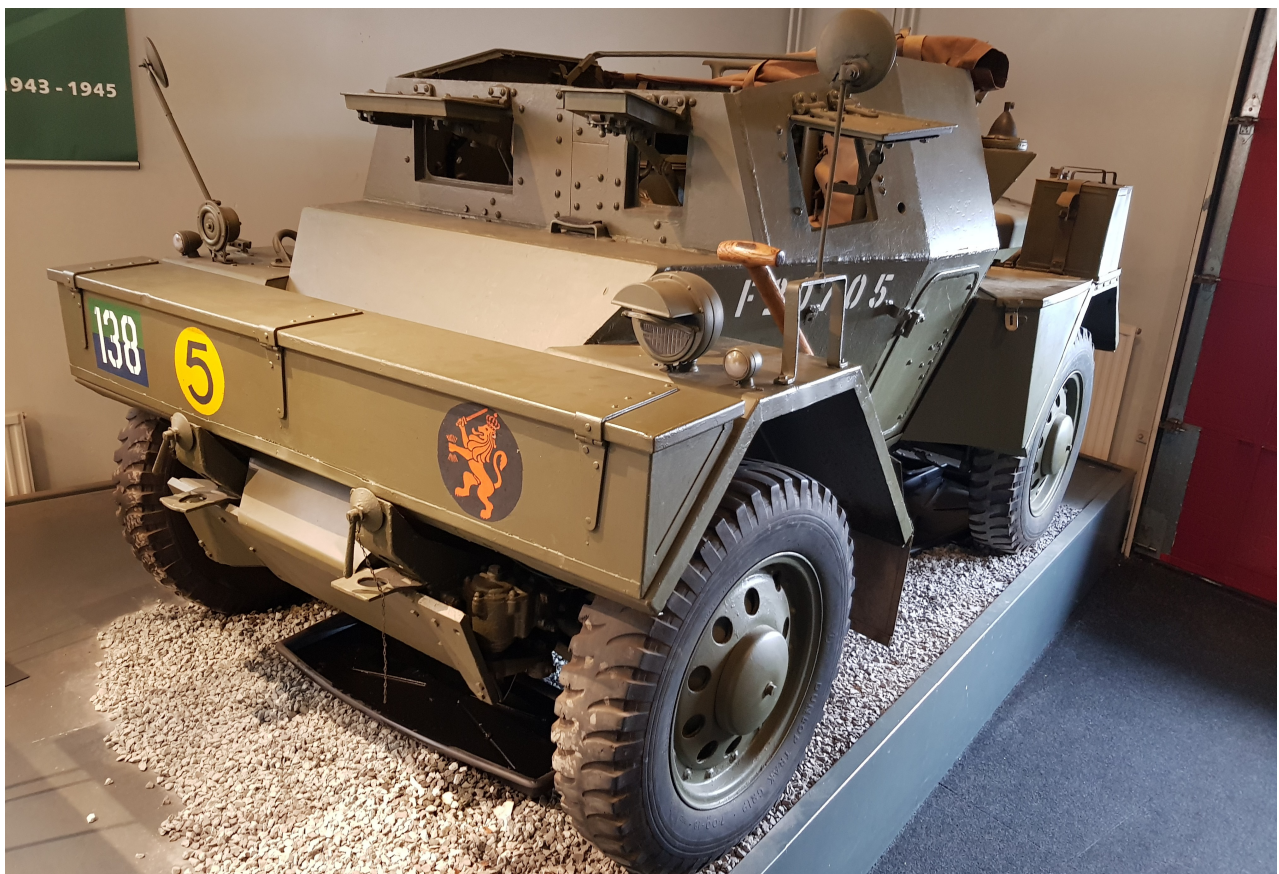

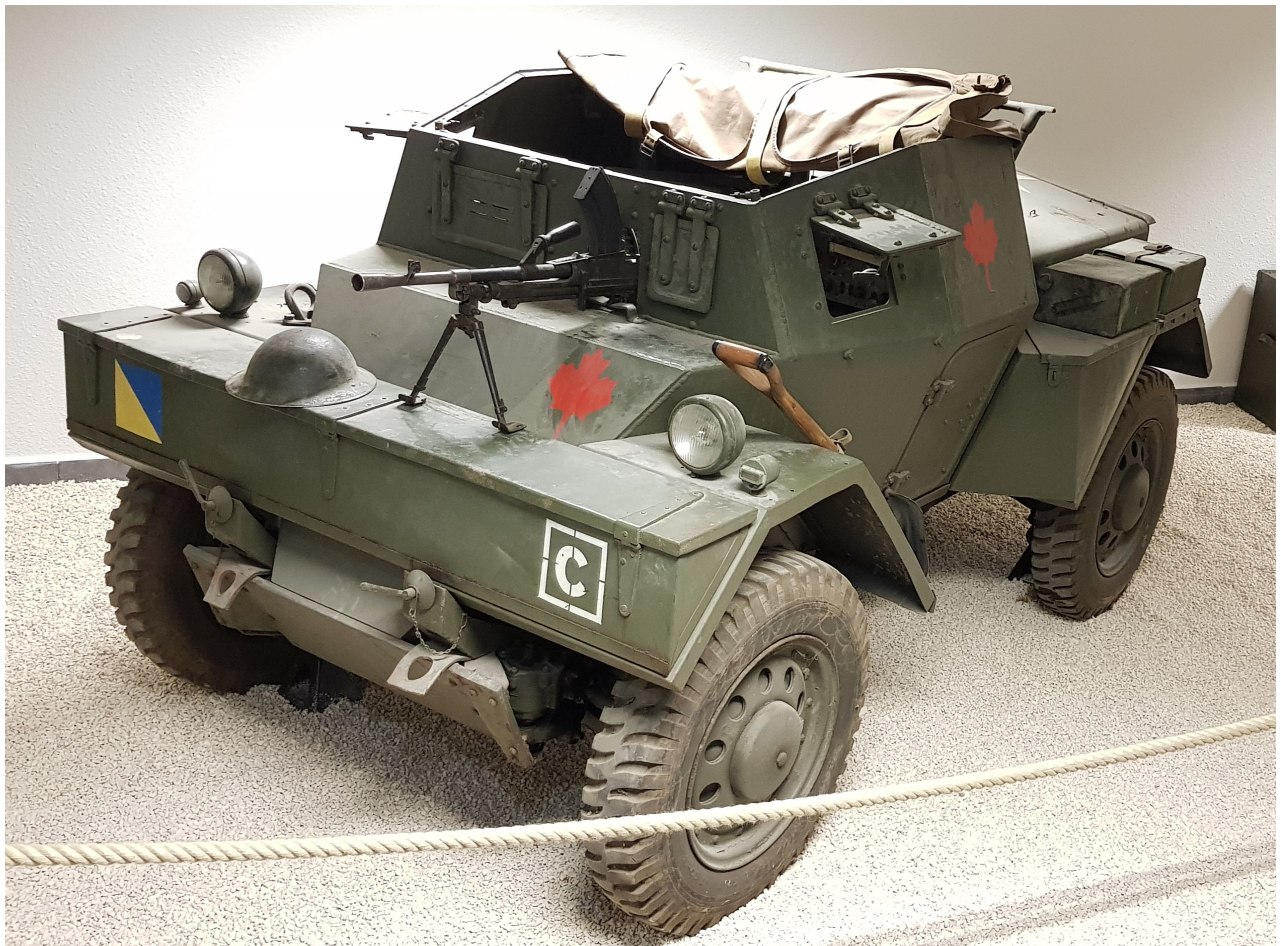

Both are rusted and need lots of bodywork....the better one is missing front box but has a good engine....The other is in very very poor state and had been vandalised and engine and cab had been burnt out and set on fire before the owner saved them from being scrapped approx 7 years ago. They had been imported from South Africa in the 1950's and then used during the British Occupation by the Special Mobile Force. Last used during the riots in Mauritius in 1969 and 1971 after Independence. They were then used as monuments outside the SMF base until late 90's when finally ended up outside the Police Museum. When this closed, they then disappeared and were vandalised before being scrapped (info. from the owner)
