38M "Toldi I" tank – Patriot Park, Kubinka (Russia)

Registration Number H-464 ("Taranov"). The tank was built by either Ganz or MÁVAG factories

38M "Toldi II a" tank – Patriot Park, Kubinka (Russia)

Registration Number H-453, captured by the Red Army during the winter 1944-45 (Yuri Pasholok)
The tank was built by either Ganz or MÁVAG factories

Registration number 1H-631. Currently being restored to running condition (Bálint Ferenc).

40M "Nimrod" anti-aircraft tank – Patriot Park, Kubinka (Russia)

Registration Number H-094, turret number 923, nickname "Csöpség". Has been assigned to the 52nd Armoured Machinegun Battalion, 2nd Armored Division, and captured by the Red Army at the end of July 1944 after an engine breakdown (Yuri Pasholok).

The tank was built by MÁVAG factory
