### L3/33 Prima Serie – Museo Storico della Fanteria, Roma (Italy)

This tank was commanded by Sergeant major Rosolino Sarotti, who died at Hamanlei. Ethiopia, November 11th 1935. He was decorated with Medaglia d'Oro (highest italian military award). The tank was later recovered and moved back to Roma

L3/33 – Museo di guerra per la pace Diego de Henriquez, Trieste (Italy)

This tank served in the RSI's army, Gruppo Corazzato "San Giusto", after 1943. Captured by allied forces, it was acquired by Diego de Henriquez in October 1945 (Stefano di Giusto)

L3/35 – Museo delle Forze Armate 1914-1945, Mmontechio-Maggiore (Italy)

Previously displayed on a military base in Kabul and used as monument to commemorate Lieutenant colonel Carmine Calò, an UN observer who was killed in Kabul, 22th August 1998. Given to the association by General Battisti in 2012



L3/35 — Museo della Cavalleria, Pinerolo (Italy)

This tank was commanded by Second Lieutenant Luigi Fuccia, who died during the Spanish Civil War. He was decorated with Medaglia d'Oro (highest italian military award)

L3/33 Lanciafiamme — Bovington Tank Museum (UK)
This flamethrower variant, complete with 520 litre unarmoured fuel trailer, was built in 1935 and used by the Ariete Armoured Division. It took part in unsuccessful attacks on Tobruk in April-May 1941 and was captured soon afterwards. Shipped to the UK for evaluation, it came to the Tank Museum in 1951 (Museum)

L 6/40 — Caserma "Mara", Solbiate Olona (Italy)

There are reasons to believe this tank was used as a tractor by the germans during WW II. It used to be in Vercelli during the fifties, then in Legnano barracks. The turret is a steel replica (it used to have a sheet metal one in Legnano), some idler wheels, the lifting jack, the antenna and the glacis lights aren't original
