in June 1991 a deeply modernized M18A1 Hellcat tank destroyer was presented by a company originating from the then Yugoslavia. The prototype featured a new fire control system, a Luna-2 infrared projector, a closed tower for greater crew protection, four smoke launchers on each side, and a new 10-cylinder Mercedez Benz diesel engine. It kept the 76.2mm M1A1 cannon and the 12.7mm M2HB machine gun on the roof in a new mount. The project did not go beyond this prototype and these veterans tank destroyers who had been stored in reserve since their discharge in 1987-88, after 40 years of service in the Venezuelan Army, were definitively disincorporated. The modernized prototype was exhibited outdoors for several years at Fort Paramacay in Valencia. it is currently at the headquarters of the Motorized Cavalry Group "Ayala" in Fuere Tiuna. Caracas
