It is one of the seven M3 Stuarts of the Australian 2/6th Armoured Regiment that were supporting troops of the 2/9th Infantry Battalion at Cape Endaiadere. On December 24, 1942 this tank suffered a hit to the driver's flap from one of the Japanese 76.2mm Type 3 Naval Gun emplaced at Buna Airfield (Old Strip). It was recovered from the Buna battlefield in mid-1973, and was transported to Port Moresby by barge. Then it was shipped to the Nimitz Museum to be displayed (http://www.pacificwrecks.com/)
