### **M4A3(76) Sherman – Holding area, Kaiserslautern (Germany)**

Formerly located at the US Army base, Grafenwöhr (Germany). Serial Number 44220, built in June, 1944

### **M4A3(76) Sherman – Lucius D. Clay Kaserne, Wiesbaden (Germany)**

Formerly located at the US Army base, Vilseck (Germany). Serial Number 44226, built in June, 1944

### M4A3(76) Sherman – Beffe (Belgium)

Serial Number 4391x, built in May, 1944. Combat vet. of the 771st Tank Battalion, hit by a chain of mines on 9 January 1945

### M4A3(76) Sherman – Clervaux (Luxemburg)

Serial Number 43911, built by Chrysler in May, 1944. Combat vet. of the 2nd Tank Bat., 9th Armored Division. During the battle for Clervaux, tanks of the 707th Tank Battalion suffered heavy losses. They were reinforced by 17 Shermans from Combat Command R, 9th Armored Division. This tank belonged to the 3rd Platoon, 2nd Tank Battalion, that defended the city of Clervaux. It was hit by a shell on the turret top without damage on 17 December, and its crew bailed out and abandoned it. During the night, the unit commander ordered the tank to be brought back, but it was put out of action on the early morning of 18 December. A shell hit the turret side and tear the main gun and shield off the turret (book "Les témoins d'acier" by Hughes Wenkin and Christian Dujardin)

### M4A3(76) Sherman – Ville-sur-Ilion (France)

Serial Number 43594, built in April, 1944. Original tank from the 12th RCA, 2nd French Armored Division, knocked out during the Battle of Dompierre in September, 1944. Despite the damages, the crew escaped without injuries

### M4A3(76) Sherman – Victorious Fatherland Liberation War Museum Pyongyang (North Korea)

Probably captured during the Korean War. Painted RN 30099900. If this RN is correct, the tank has been built in April, 1944. It has evidence of use as a dozer
